For example, include any information you wish to be considered about the welfare or best interests of any children you have in the UK. You must demonstrate you have a genuine, subsisting and active parental relationship.

You should also include any exceptional circumstances or compassionate factors.

If you do not provide these documents, your application may be delayed or refused.

- A letter from relative(s) or friend(s) confirming I or my partner lived with them for some or all of the 2-year period
- Evidence of your partner's immigration status in the UK
- A marriage certificate, or a reasonable equivalent
- Divorce or dissolution certificat
- Proof of property ownership from the owner of the property you live in, such as a mortgage statement
- Copy of an ID document of the owner of the property you live in, such as a passport
- Letter signed by the owner of the property you live in stating that you have permission to live there
- Child's birth certificate
- Annual self-assessment tax return to HMRC (copy or print out) for the last full financial year, or for the last two such years (where those documents show the necessary level of gross income as an average of those two years) for your partner
- Each partner's Unique Tax Reference Number (UTR) and/or the UTR of the partnership or business for your partner
- Evidence of ongoing self-employment through the provision of at least one of the following: a bank statement dated no more than three months earlier than the date of application showing transactions relating to ongoing trading, or evidence dated no more than three months earlier than the date of application of the renewal of a license to trade or of ongoing payment of business rates, business-related insurance premiums, employer National Insurance contributions or franchise payments to the parent company for your partner
- Evidence of the amount of tax payable, paid and unpaid for the last full financial year
- Evidence to show appropriate planning permission or local planning authority consent is held to operate the type or class of business at the trading address (where this is a local authority requirement) for your partner

- Personal bank statements for the same 12-month period as the tax return(s) showing that the income from self-employment has been paid into an account in the name of the person or in the name of the person and their partner jointly for your partner
- Proof of registration with HMRC as self-employed if available for your partner
- Statement of Account (SA200 or SA302) for the last full financial year, or for the last two such years (where those documents show the necessary level of gross income as an average of those two years) for your partner
- Where the person holds or held a separate business bank account(s), bank statements for the same 12-month period as the tax return(s) for your partner
- Personal bank statements showing the money you receive from your other income sources has been paid into your account or an account in your and your partner's names

**Providing your documents**

You must provide your documents after you submit your application, these can be originals or copies. **Any passports provided must be originals.**
